Overview: This solution paper will accurately take you through the procedures necessary to import a text file into a SolidBuilder working drawing.

Solution:

Text files can be created in a word processing program such as Word and imported into a SolidBuilder drawing to save a great deal of time. These files may be specification sheets, disclaimers etc. and are created and saved as text (*.txt) files.

- 1) Create the text file making sure it is saved as a *.txt file (Text Only).
- 2) From the Working Drawing menus select Text and set the drop down window to File.
- 3) Set the justification, font and text size.
- 4) Mark the location for the text file.
- 5) A select file dialog box opens. Select the .txt file you want to insert.
- 6) The file is now inserted.
